



> Jesus is from the wrong _____
 For the priest we are talking about belongs to a different tribe, whose members have never served at the altar as priests. What I mean is, our Lord came from the tribe of Judah, and Moses never mentioned priests coming from that tribe. - Heb 7:13-14 NLT

> Jesus had to _____ the Law
 So if perfection was through the Levitical priesthood (for on the basis of it the people received the Law), what further need was there for another priest to arise according to the order of Melchizedek, and not be designated according to the order of Aaron? - Heb 7:11

> Jesus is a _____ Priest
 For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God, who met Abraham as he was returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him, to whom also Abraham apportioned a tenth of all the spoils, was first of all, by the translation of his name, king of righteousness, and then also king of Salem, which is king of peace. Without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the Son of God, he remains a priest perpetually. - Heb 7:1-3

> How is a Melchizedek Priest _____?
 And this is clearer still, if another priest arises according to the likeness of Melchizedek, who has become a priest not on the basis of a law of physical requirement, but according to the power of an indestructible life. - Heb 7:15-16

> From God's own _____ - with an oath
 The Lord says to my Lord: "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet." The Lord has sworn and will not change His mind, "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek." - Ps 110:1 & 4

This new system was established with a solemn oath. Aaron's descendants became priests without such an oath, but there was an oath regarding Jesus. For God said to Him, "The Lord has taken an oath and will not break His vow: 'You are a priest forever.'" Because of this oath, Jesus is the One who guarantees this better covenant with God. - Heb 7:20-22 NLT

> Better because this priesthood is _____
 There were many priests under the old system, for death prevented them from remaining in office. But because Jesus lives forever, His priesthood lasts forever. Therefore He is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through Him. He lives forever to intercede with God on their behalf. - Heb 7:23-25 NLT

But this Man, because He continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them. - Heb 7:24-25 KJV
