BOTH EVENTS:

- occurred on a mountain
- happened to a newly redeemed people.
- involved God giving a gift
- included God coming in fire
- had similar sounds and symbols

Now Mount Sinai was all in smoke because the Lord descended upon it in fire; and its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the entire mountain quaked violently. When the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him with thunder. - Ex 19:18-19

And suddenly a noise like a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And tongues that looked like fire appeared to them, distributing themselves, and a tongue rested on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with different tongues, as the Spirit was giving them the ability to speak out. - Acts 2:2-4

SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCES:

- Sinai had God's Law written on tablets of stone
Pentecost writes God's Law in our hearts
- The day the Law was given 3,000 died
The day of Pentecost 3,000 came to life

Not that we are adequate in ourselves so as to consider anything as having come from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God, who also made us adequate as servants of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life. - 2Cor 3:5-6
